This temple was built by the Ahom king Siva Singha and it is one of the prime places of worship of the *Shakti* cult. This devalaya or temple is known for its annual Durga Puja. There is an idol of the goddess Durga in the sanctum sanctorum, which is housed in a small underground cave. Many stone statues have been excavated from temple premises of Dirgheswari.

The temple is situated amidst beautiful natural surroundings. Therefore, the trip was very pleasant, besides being enriching for the students. Thus, it was a successful and fulfilling experience for the students.
