## ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-23


I'm pleased to provide the annual report for the academic year 2022-23, highlighting numerous developmental initiatives undertaken by the college during this period.

1. A total number of **1017** students were admitted for all disciplines.
2. Throughout the academic year 2022-23, the college organized **23** Add-on courses tailored to augment students' knowledge base, drawing the participation of **1705** students. These courses served as a conduit for students to bolster their subject mastery and proficiency in their preferred areas of study.
3. The Mentor-Mentee system serves as a cornerstone in nurturing our campus's student body. Each mentor is entrusted with a cohort of mentees (every mentor will have **30** mentees), guiding and facilitating their journey towards becoming accomplished and conscientious citizens.
4. Nalbari College embraced academic excellence by orchestrating an in-house symposium, where faculty members showcased their research in seminar presentation, followed by insightful discussions, fostering a vibrant scholarly atmosphere.
5. Students have embarked on innovative projects as integral components of their academic curriculum. A total of **1242** students immersed themselves in fieldwork/project works over the course of the year.
6. **562** students out of a total of **641** achieved success in their final semester examinations across both undergraduate and postgraduate programs.
7. Total **122** students are placed in various reputed companies/Govt service and **124** students opted towards higher education during this academic year.
8. Students have participated in many Cultural/Sports/Games events and extra-curricular activities during this academic year; and have won **52 prizes**.
9. Faculty members are encouraged to pursue Doctoral degree, one of faculty member is awarded Ph. D. degree in this academic year and they published research articles in reputed journals.
10. **Total 18 faculty members have attended Faculty development programs/Workshops and total 39 non-teaching members attended Skill enhancement/Training programmes.**
11. A Total Number of **05** Research Articles have been published in Reputed International/national Journals and **39** number of Book chapters have been published during the academic year.
12. Faculty members were provided with financial support for attending conferences, workshops etc. and total **23** faculty members have been provided with financial support to attend seminar/conferences/

workshops and towards membership fee of professional bodies with financial support of Rs. 37,200/- during the academic year.

13. Nalbari College participated in AISHE
14. ERP software has been used for effective monitoring of result analysis, admission process, examination process, faculty attendance, Institutional repository, and e-resources, etc.
15. Central library will be updated by procuring latest books and journals every year and provides access to INFLIBNET [NLIST], E-BOOKS, E-Resources [World -ebooks Library, Taylor Francis eBooks, Swayam Prabha, Springer eBooks, Project Gutenberg, JSTOR, e-PG Pathshala, NATIONAL DIGITAL LIBRARY, Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ), Directory of Open Access Books (DOAB)] etc.
16. College signed 17 MoUs with renowned universities/organizations during the academic year.
17. Solar power plant is installed using solar panels to convert solar energy to electrical energy with a generating capacity of 20 KW as a part of institute's green initiatives.
18. College implemented rainwater harvesting system in the year 2003 and being maintained successfully with a total capacity of 1000 litres.
19. College installed Sewage Treatment Plants in the year 2010 and being maintained successfully to recycle used and waste water with a capacity of 200 litres. Recycled water is being utilized for watering the gardens.
