POLICY FOR SCHOLARSHIP AND FREESHIPS TO THE STUDENTS OF NALBARI COLLEGE

1.0 Introduction

Nalbari College, Nalbari, upholds the belief that to foster outstanding academic performance and excellence in various fields, the institution should offer a range of scholarships, prizes, medals, and awards. These accolades are designed to recognize and encourage excellence in specific courses, academic programs, social service, athletics, cultural activities, and research and development in specified fields. This approach aims to motivate studentsto achieve high standards and contribute positively to their respective domains. The awards can be funded either from the institution's own resources (Own College Fund), Governmental and Nongovernmental sources.

These incentives support the holistic development of students, encouraging them to excel not only in their academic pursuits but also in their overall personal growth. This, in turn, strengthens the college's reputation and contributes to a vibrant, progressive academic community.

2.0 Objective

The Primary objectives of scholarship/freeshipsare -

- (i) To reward outstanding academic performances.
- (ii) To provide financial assistance to meritorious students from low-income families without any reservations.
 - (iii) To reward students for excellence in extracurricular activities.
- (iv) To provide financial assistance for student field survey and educational tours.
 - (v) To offer fee concessions for divyangjan (differently-abled) students.

3.0 Scope

(i) The merit prizes for academic excellence have been awarded to the rank holders under Gauhati University for all UG and PG courses and also to the batch toppers of each department of the college each year.

- (ii)Financial assistance has been provided to meritorious students from low-income families in terms of fee concession, student aid, book purchase facility etc.
- (iii) Students with significant achievements in state, national, or international level are recognized and felicitated to encourage their continued excellence.
- (iv) Institutional financial assistance has been introduced for field trips/Educational tours/Excursionsforstudents to promote hands-on learning experiences, enhancing their understanding of theoretical concepts and also to foster social skills, teamwork, and a broader perspective on real-world applications.
- (iv) Financial assistance will be provided to meritorious divyangjan students in terms of fee concession, student aid, book purchase facility.

4.0 Procedure of Availing the Award/ Scholarships/ Prizes/ Medals

- (i) In the case of Academic excellence Prizes, the College Award & Scholarship Committee prepare the rank holders list from the Gauhati University result sheet.
- (ii) After admission, notice seeking applications from students who wants to avail freeship/scholarship of this facility is put onthecollege notice board as well as on the college website. Students are required to fill out theprescribed form and submit it along with required documents such as income certificate, marksheet of last examination, bank account details, ID proof etc. Fee concession and Student aid committee scrutinizes the applications and interact personally with the applicant for genuineness. On the basis of satisfaction, the committee decide the amount or nature of aid to be provided to each student and prepare the list of recommended students to the principal for approval.
- (iii) Individual departments need to apply for Institutional financial assistancefor studentfield trips, educational tours, or Excursions.
- (iv) Students participating in district, state, or national level activities and cultural programs receive financial support if they apply through the proper channels or the students' union.
